

FKA Tips for Taking the CompTIA CTT+ Examination

- Instructors are responsible for maintaining a safe environment.
- Teaching and evaluation methods must be legally defensible.
- Learners meeting course objectives is paramount.
- Instructors must ensure that learners have and maintain self-esteem.
- In order to help meet course objectives, instructors are responsible for evaluating information and situations and then making appropriate adjustments to methods, media, motivation, and time spent on topics. However, instructors must never change the course objectives in isolation from the course developers.
- Instructors should be humble subject matter experts and prove their expertise by answering questions thoroughly and relating content to real-life job situations.
- Instructor feelings and preferences don't count at all - it's the learners who are important.
- ASK the learners for feedback when necessary.
- Learning is an active process; and instructors must do everything possible to involve their learners.
- Adults learn by relating what they already know to the new material, preferably by using examples.
- **During the examination, when all else fails, try to remember the intent of the CTT+ objective!**
